Out of an abundance of caution and from a place of being concerned for our members and attendees health and safety, Recovery Specialist Insurance Group and Allied Finance Adjusters Conference Inc have made the difficult decision to cancel the REPO2020 Conference and Annual Meetings scheduled to be held at the Motor City Casino & Hotel in Detroit, Michigan this June.

While we are hopeful that the Coronavirus – COVID19 situation will have subsided by mid-June – the truth is we just don't know for sure. With the situation constantly evolving and your businesses being impacted daily, we decided this cancellation would be the best course of action.

We know that some of you may have pre-existing conditions that make the idea of contracting the virus very scary and that many may not have health insurance or the ability to get tested or treatments needed – and we don't want you having to make that difficult decision.

If you made a hotel reservation under the group link or code, the hotel will automatically cancel your reservation and send a confirmation email to the email address provided. If you did not use our link or tell the hotel you would be with the group to make your reservation, you will still need to contact the hotel directly and cancel that reservation. If you have already made airline reservations, many airlines are offering no charge cancellation or change fee opportunities if you contact them by a certain date – that date may vary by airline. We would strongly recommend you do it today, so it doesn't slip your mind!

We also know that work flow is already being impacted and as a result so will your revenues and income. To help with this, all registration fees will be refunded. If you have registered for the seminar, no further action is required on your part in order to get the refund of your fees. If you have not received your refund by either a credit to the card used to pay the fees or a check by April 17th, please contact our office.

Look for additional information in the future from both Allied and RSIG about how each group's annual business meetings may be rescheduled or handled through other avenues.
